Successes, Partnerships, Projects, and Deployments

- Data vs Inclusion and Maintenance
 - Should resources only follow the data
 - ▶ Don't we want smaller rural partners included in safety programs
 - ▶ Do rural partners need resources to <u>maintain</u> their safety gains
- State Highway Safety Office Perspective
 - Reduce crashes, save lives
 - ▶ In New York State: 600 police agencies, 300 grantees
 - ▶ Data-only award process would fund 10-20 agencies
